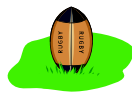
Netball selection of teams

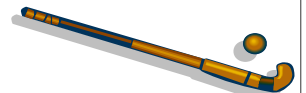


HOT DOG DAY - FRIDAY 26, MARCH

Please note the change in times to the dress rehearsal make up for all Grades.
