- The examination will assess mathematical reasoning, scientific skills and English language skills.
- Application forms are available on the Thandulwazi website or may be collected from the Reception at St Stithians Girls' College (between 08:00-13:00).

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed and their custodians will need to provide a declaration of financial status. The College and Thandulwazi Trust reserve the right not to award the scholarship if a suitable candidate is not found.
