



Support Thandulwazi with an Annual or Monthly Pledge

For as little as **R150 per month**, you could sponsor a teacher or learner to attend the Thandulwazi programmes offered.



- The **Thandulwazi Saturday School**, targets Grade 10, 11 and 12 learners from under-resourced schools serving communities in disadvantaged areas. The focus is on providing extra tuition in core subjects, such as Maths, Science, Accounting and English. It costs R150 per month (i.e. R 1800 per year) to fund one learner to attend the 30 Saturday sessions. This covers the costs of teachers and tutors; all printing and worksheets provided; the annual *Mathletics* Licence fee and an individual log-in for every student; access to computers and the internet on Saturdays for *Mathletics* practice.
- The **Thandulwazi-Rokunda Teacher Development Programme**, provides up-skilling workshops and professional development for teachers at state schools, teaching in Grade R to Grade 9. The focus is on Maths/ numeracy; literacy and technology. It costs R150 per month (i.e. R 1800 per year) to fund one teacher to attend all 11 Saturday sessions offered. This covers the costs of workshop facilitators, basic stationery for teachers, all printing and handouts, refreshments, access to the computer labs and the internet, the annual *Mathletics* Licence fee and log-ins for teachers.

Should you be willing to sponsor a teacher or learner, two payment options are available:

- (i) A once off annual donation of R1800 or
- (ii) A monthly stop order of R150,00 x 12 months

SETTING UP UP A MONTHLY STOP ORDER

A stop order, or scheduled payment order, is a regular monthly payment (or annual payment) you can set-up on your account with your bank to pay a third party (e.g. the Thandulwazi Trust).

- If you wish to make a payment by stop order, please be in touch with your bank and complete the required form, instructing the bank in writing to debit your account with a specific amount regularly and to credit the account of the beneficiary.
- Some banks allow clients to set up a scheduled payment on-line. You will need to check if this is an option with your personal bankers please.
- Once the stop order has been arranged, the payment will run automatically until such time as you cancel it with the bank. To cancel or amend the stop order you must notify your bank.
