- Ability to work systemically within the broader school context, as well as within a team of support professionals
- Ethical conduct in line with HPCSA and other relevant regulations; the ability to maintain strict confidentiality and appropriate boundaries in all matters related to work

### Key requirements:

- Professional qualifications (Masters degree in Educational Psychology) & appropriate experience; teaching experience is preferred
- Commitment to working with adolescents and an understanding of issues affecting teenage girls
- The ability to prioritise, multi-task and work under pressure and within a dynamic school environment
- Excellent verbal & written communication, organisational, administrative, inter-personal and emotional intelligence skills
- The ability to work effectively both independently and as part of a team and wider system with multiple stakeholders
- A commitment and proactive approach to reflective practice as well as continuous personal and professional development
- Computer literacy with a sound knowledge of Microsoft Office
- Professional registration as an intern psychologist with the HPCSA, which is current and compliant in CPD requirements
