The requirements of the position:

- Attend to the pastoral wellness of the students
- Supervise the students at meal times
- Supervise homework
- Ensure that the students carry out their duties in the house and that the students fulfil the requirements of the boarding house contract
- To ensure cleanliness and hygiene standards are maintained in the boarding house
- To ensure all equipment in the house is maintained properly
- Maintain discipline within the house by encouraging teamwork and cohesiveness
- Be able to supervise the students during the week time and over weekends as per the duty schedule
- Be available to attend functions / events over weekends when required
- Any staff member working within a school is required to have a sexual offender's clearance certificate
- A willingness to work within the values, Christian ethos and mission of the College as well to participate in the broader life of the school
- The successful applicant will be provided with accommodation at the boarding facility. This is a small bedsitter flat with a bathroom and kitchenette, suitable for a single person only
