#### GALA RULES

- 1. Juniors are U14 or U15
- 2. Seniors are U16, U17 or U19
- 3. Order of Individual Medley: Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle
- 4. Order of Medley Relay: Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle
- 5. The Four Age Group Relay (Event 3) four separate age groups, choice of which four is at the discretion of the coach.
- 6. The 6 x 50m Open Freestyle Relay (Event 13) is open to all age groups.
- 7. Butterfly relays: two swimmers per age group, swum in any order.
- 8. Age group taken as of 1 January 2020
- 9. Swimmers may compete in ONE AGE GROUP ONLY throughout the gala. Swimmers may compete in a higher age group than their own, but not in a lower age group.
- 10. Swimmers may only swim in a MAXIMUM of 6 EVENTS (excluding the Dash for Cash)
- 11. On registration, a team list must be handed in—there will be no changes allowed thereafter.
- 12. All FINA rules will apply. One start gala (no false starts are permitted and no strapping is permitted)

#### **DIVING RULES**

There will be 1m and 3m boards available.

#### UNDER 15

TWO dives from different groups with NO limit of degree of difficulty plus ONE voluntary dive from any group with no limit of degree of difficulty. No dive number may be repeated.

#### UNDER 16

TWO dives from different groups with NO limit of degree of difficulty plus TWO voluntary dives from any group with no limit of degree of difficulty. No dive number may be repeated.

#### OPEN

TWO dives from different groups with NO limit of degree of difficulty plus THREE voluntary dives from any group with no limit of degree of difficulty. No dive number may be repeated.

#### \*Maximum of 3 divers per age group

#### WATER POLO RULES

- 1. All new FINA rules will apply.
- 2. Team lists (13 players ONLY) must be handed in at the managers meeting on Friday morning—there will be no changes allowed thereafter.
- 3. All matches will start on time and will be 4 x 5 min chukkas playing time (start-stop) with no time-outs. During playoffs 1 x time out per team will be allowed.
- 4. All teams must supply their own caps for every game. The team wearing WHITE caps must start on the LEFT of the OFFICIALS' table.
- 5. Results will be determined in the following manner: 2 points for a win | 1 point for a draw | 0 points for a loss
- 6. In the event of a draw all FINA rules will apply.
- 7. If there is a draw in the PLAYOFF matches, a penalty shootout consisting of 3 girls from each team will decide the winner.
- 8. In the FINAL, should the result still be a draw, a penalty shootout consisting of 5 girls from each team will decide the winner.
- 9. The match referee's decision is FINAL.
- 10. Any player found guilty of <u>misconduct</u>, <u>violence or brutality</u> shall be dealt with in Accordance with FINA rules.
- 11. In the event of lightening, all play will be suspended until the 'all-clear signal' has sounded. Thereafter, matches will be shortened, adjusted or moved to the next day.

Lightning Siren



The College has a lightning system linked to the SA Weather Bureau. In the event of lightning within a 15km radius of the College, the alarm will be sounded with one long siren. When you hear the siren, you need to take shelter out of the open immediately. Move off metal grandstands immediately. Do not panic and do not run, but make your way towards the nearest school building or your vehicle (if close by) and take shelter until you hear the all-clear, which is two shorter sounding sirens. The system is set to give us the allclear only after 31 minutes of no lightning activity within our 15km radius.
