FEES are payable in terms of the election made by parents, either annually by EFT, or monthly by debit order.

ANNUAL FEES are payable on or before 12 January 2025.

MONTHLY FEES are payable via debit order on the $1^{\rm st}$ or $7^{\rm th}$ working day of each month from January to October. In the event of these days falling on a Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday, the debit order will be processed on the following business day.

APPLICATION FEE per student is charged for new enrollment applications. This fee of R650 is non-refundable.

¹ A non-refundable Entrance Fee is payable upon enrollment at St Stithians College.

² The Grade RRR and RR Entrance Fee is a partial payment of the full Grades R to 9 Entrance Fee. The balance of the Entrance Fee is required by August of the year prior to entering Grade RR or R.

³ An Annual Capital Development Fee per student is charged as a dedicated source of revenue for facilities capital expenditure and campus enhancement.

⁴The Back-up Power Levy is charged to assist in funding the purchase, maintenance and operation of the generators.
