LaLiga Camps in partnership with IBERCUP have received an unprecedented number of requests from youth to participate in the first international LaLiga football camp.

17<sup>th</sup> August 2021, Johannesburg, LaLiga Camps who have partnered with international football youth organization IBERCUP for the next three years to host football camps in South Africa have been inundated with young players around the country wanting to participate in the first camp to be run in Johannesburg from the 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 29<sup>th</sup> of August 2021.

Since launching there have been over 2500 requests from players all over the country to register for the camps. Due to Covid protocols participation has been restricted to 120 players from the ages of u10 to u18 for both male and female players.

The LaLiga Camps players clinic will be run over five days from the 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 27<sup>th</sup> of August with LaLiga UEFA Pro Licence coaches The LaLiga camps will be conducted by experienced UEFA PRO Licenced coaches Tony Alvarez Zamora and Luis Martinez. Zamora has worked for LaLiga in countries such as England, Nigeria, Thailand, China and Indonesia, and was most recently Academy Co-Ordinator and Under 19 Head Coach at LaLiga club R.D Mallorca, where Africa's most successful LaLiga export Samuel Eto'o first made his name. Martinez is an experienced coach who has previously worked with the youth teams of LaLiga club, C.D Leganes.

In the build-up to the week of the LaLiga camps taking place at St Stithians College, IBERCUP are proud to announce the inclusion as guests of honour at the inaugural launch on the 26<sup>th</sup> of August, representatives from the South African Football Association, the Gauteng Provincial Government and Special Olympics to participate on stage at the event.

"I am proud to say that with our consumer brand partners we have been able to cover the costs of 70 players and 40 coaches to attend the camps, and we intend providing the same for Cape Town in November and Durban in December. This is only the start and we will expand the project to reach all corners of the country to identify talent and give players and coaches the opportunity to participate in international football projects.
