St Stithians is a national asset

We consider St Stithians College to be "a national asset".

Our College is, in many ways, one of a kind: it is a village of schools, offering a unique co-ordinate model, situated on 105 hectares of land, in the heart of a city. St Stithians has the reputation of being a leading educational institution in South Africa and is globally recognised as a centre of academic excellence.



However, like most independent schools, both nationally and internationally, future sustainability is a concern for Saints. Rising costs and tuition fees and the shrinking pool of parents who can afford such fees are threats facing most independent schools across the world.

It is key to secure the future sustainability of St Stithians College, as a 21st Century institution of academic excellence, for generations to come; hence the importance of the Foundation and the Saints Endowment Fund.

Robert Forman Worldwide, great academic institutions, like Harvard, have recognised the importance of building up an endowment fund to provide for the long-term future of the institution.

The future sustainability of St Stithians is the primary focus of the Foundation. The Foundation Governors take a long-term, forward-looking view.

Future sustainability has two key components:

- Financial sustainability: the focus is on saving for the future and building up an endowment fund for the College (the "inreach" strategy), through the Saints Endowment Fund.
- Relevance to the broader South African society: through the programmes
 managed by the Thandulwazi Trust, ensuring that St Stithians is involved
 in educational projects that contribute towards improving teaching and
 learning in schools across Gauteng and add value to the quality of education received by historically disadvantaged South Africans (the "outreach"
 strategy).

The funds raised by the Endowment Fund are mainly from members of the St Stithians community and will be used for key projects identified to benefit the Saints community.

There are four main focus areas:

St Stithians Teacher Development St Stithians Learner Scholarships & Bursaries St Stithians Infrastructure/ Facilities Development St Stithians support for Outreach Programmes

The funds are managed by a separately constituted board of Fund Governors, to ensure the highest standards of governance in the safeguarding and investments of the funds raised.

The Endowment Fund is primarily for the benefit of the St Stithians schools and to ensure the long-term sustainability of the College as a 21st Century institution of academic excellence.
