- Long term Direction, Reduction on the Municipal Water Grid and be Self-Sustainable (70% off grid),
- Ensure Water Security within St Stithians College Campus for continuous supply of Potable Water, Irrigation and any other Self Sustainability purpose
- Build a Water Treatment Plant in within 2021 to process existing ground water sources to meet the current and future potable water demands
- To create, develop and initiate Water Security Awareness Programme across the St Stithians College Community (Learners, Staff, Parents and the Community at large)
- The overall objective of the project is to Source, Process and Supply 250 000 litres per day of potable water that complies with the full legal SANS 241 requirements
- The total solution must comply with Local, Provincial and National Regulations both in terms of water extraction from alternate sources as well as production of potable water from non-municipal water sources
