- ◆ St Stithians is part of the international Eco Schools project. Last year we were proud to receive our Platinum Award for the second year for our ongoing and sustainable environmental learning and management and for being a great example of a 'green school'.

RECYCLING INITIATIVES

- ◆ Products for recycling may be deposited at the Recycling Depot (opposite the Boys College Boarding Houses) or alternatively in one of the banks of recycling bins around campus.
- ◆ E-waste for all electronic goods, including old computers, can be deposited in the cage at the Recycling Depot. Please ask Sydney, the Depot Manager to open the cage.
- ◆ Paper can be deposited in boxes in the classrooms.
- ◆ Please deposit all used ink and printer cartridges in the 'greenOffice' boxes in the foyers. The greenSCHOOL programme diverts cartridges from landfill so they can be reused or recycled.
