Don't forget the Monthly Club Draw which takes place on 7 February with a roll over amount of R21 000 to start 2013.







The same concept of Michael Matthews was kept from the original piece :

- a) The Dukes honour God in song
- b) The Holy Trinity:
 - Three figures
 - Each figure has three fingers (two and thumb) together which is a symbol of blessing
 - The basher hats also symbolise halos
- c) The Unity of One and All, representing all the Saints, across the campus.
