Celebrating OSA Sports Achievers

Holly Norton (2011), recently won Silver in the A Final of the W4- at the 27th Summer Universide in Kazan whilst representing the Ohio State University.

Rodney Robb (1968) started playing hockey at the age of 32. In 2010 he was a member of the first South African Grand Masters Hockey Team (60 to 65 year olds) who patricipated in the Grand Masters Hockey World Cup in Cape Town in September 2010 where they came 8th out of the 9 participating countries. In August 2012, they participated in Oxford, England where they finished 6th out of 10 countries. He is now in the squad for World Cup in the Haque, Netherlands in June 2014.

Jono Ross (2008) is currently playing for the Blue Bulls. His regular position is number 8 or flanker. He started off playing for the Golden Lions and represented them at the 2007 and 2008 Under–18 Academy Week tournaments. He also represented them in the 2008 Under–19 Currie Cup competition. He then joined the Blue Bulls and played for their Under–21 team in 2010 and 2011. He made his senior debut in 2011, coming on as a substitute in the 2011 Vodacom Cup match against SWD Eagles, as well as in the quarter-final match against former team the Golden Lions. He made his debut in the Currie Cup competition a few months later in 2011 against Griquas and made one further appearance that season. He established himself as a regular in the team for the 2012 Vodacom Cup, making eight starts and scoring a try. In 2013, he was called into the Bulls Super Rugby side for their match against the Kings. In addition to playing for the Blue Bulls, he also represented UP-Tuks in the annual Varsity Cup competition in 2011, 2012 and 2013.




