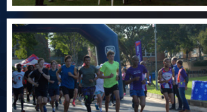

WELCOME FROM THE RECTOR



It is always a pleasure to offer a welcome to our SportsFest but this year there is a special layer of excitement. 2023 marks the 70th anniversary of the founding of the College. The first Rugby Festival, as it was then, was held over Easter in 1984 and was the brainchild of Boys' College staff members Piet van Tonder and Eric van der Westhuizen, who had seen the success of the Prince Edward Festival in Harare. It is wonderful how innovative ideas travel and flourish, and I know there will be a great deal of shared learning and inspiration over the 2023 Festival.

The shape and size of the Festival has grown beyond anything that could have been imagined by Piet and Eric, and we acknowledge their legacy. We celebrate that, even though SportsFest has grown into the extraordinary event that it is today, we still hold fast to the original intention as described by Walter Macfarlane in his school history, To Serve the Future Hour: "...it provided an opportunity for schools who would not normally encounter one another on the rugby field (now many fields and courts), to do so. The emphasis was on the joy of playing: there was no 'best team'." This is the 39th year of the College Festival, excluding 2020.

This is why we are here, for the 'joy of playing.' That sense of joy fits well with the College theme for 2023, a 'Legacy of Happy Fulfilment'. Those words are on the Chapel



foundation stone and mark the fulfilment by the Trustees of the commitment to found St Stithians. Now, we see these words not as an end point but as the beginning of a call to continue to be a school of 'Happy Fulfilment' by ensuring equal opportunity for one and all to thrive in their unique way.

You will have abundant opportunities as participants or spectators to feel the joy and uniting power of sport. The players will dig deep to win their games but more than that, they will learn about themselves and how they can stretch themselves. Some will win, and by the nature of sport, some will lose, but all will come away enriched.

We have a very full programme, starting with the Prep Festival on 30, 31 March and 01 April.

There are over 100 teams from 60 schools with over 1000 participants. The Prep teams will be playing netball, rugby, squash, and tennis. This is the first time the Grade 2s will be playing Interhouse Hockey on the Astros on Saturday, 1 April 2023 from 08h00 – 10h00.

The College Festival runs on 5, 6, 8 and 10 April. There are 88 teams from 87 schools, with over 1100 participants. The Thandulwazi Maths & Science Academy are part of the College Festival, and this year are fielding both a boys' and a girls' football team (2022 was boys' only). This year marks the 10th anniversary of tennis as part of the Festival.

As a Methodist school, we are mindful that the Festival takes place over the Easter weekend and we welcome all members of any denomination to join us at our services.

Good Friday: Easter Services will be held in the Chapel from 07h45 – 08h30.

Easter Sunday: Chapel at 09h00 will include a children's ministry.

It is my sincere wish that this SportsFest will be an experience of 'Happy Fulfilment'

for all involved. I look forward to meeting you on the side-lines or in the hospitality areas. I hope that you enjoy this campus, so beautifully maintained by our Ops Team. I thank the Festival organising teams at all levels for their months of hard work and preparation; as well as our many sponsors who have helped to shape the Festival into the welcoming experience and in particular, our headline sponsor, Standard Bank.

A special thank you to the Rowing Team for the efficient and enthusiastic management of the extremely busy gates during our Festival.

The fields and courts are ready – as American football player and coach Paul Bryant said: 'It's not the will to win that matters – everyone has that. It's the will to prepare to win that matters.' We are as prepared as we can be – let us begin.

Wishing everyone a fun filled and successful festival and that a good time is had by one and all.

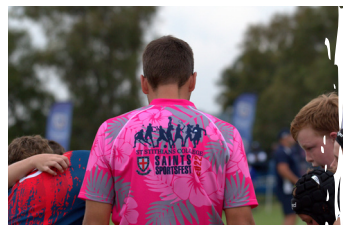
