WELCOME FROM THE RECTOR

The Saints SportsFest has become not only a premier sporting event but a celebration of camaraderie and an opportunity to meet old friends and make new ones. On behalf of our family of seven schools, I welcome you to the 2024 Saints Sports Festival. Our College theme for the year, All4One and One4All, captures the spirit of the Festival. This is an event about competition but more than that, it is an opportunity to support one another as teams and stretch individuals to achieve their goals. Sport is empowering and creates a sense of belonging that comes with being part of a team. I know that our campus will be ringing with the shouts of encouragement and that is at the heart of what this Festival is about as we embody All4One and One4All.

We mark a special anniversary this year as we celebrate 40 years of the Sports Festival. From the simple idea of a rugby festival for boys to celebrate the game and sportsmanship, we have grown to a six-sport, fully inclusive Festival. The photographs in the programme show our beginnings but what can never be shown are the memories made over the years that remain bright for many. We pay tribute to Colin Hall, one of the founders of, and the first Chair of the Festival. We are grateful to Colin for his vision, energy and servant leadership that he shared so generously with St Stithians and the many thousands who were fortunate enough to know him. I know that this year will add to that treasure trove of good memories. This will be especially true for our alumni as they compete in the Alumni Games, which enters its sixth year and continues to grow in popularity.

SportsFest begins with the Prep Festival which runs from 21 – 23 March. Thursday is the Human Rights Day holiday and Friday is a school holiday. The long weekend makes it an ideal opportunity for families to be fully part of the fun over the three



days of events. We look forward to welcoming you to the excitement of SportsFest. With 111 teams and 1131 participants from 38 schools, this promises to be a sporting feast of netball, rugby, squash, and tennis.

Our littlest ones have not been left out. The Junior Prep will be involved in hockey clinics on Saturday, 23 March 2024 at the Astros from 08h00 – 10h30. It is exciting to wonder how our little ones will develop over time.

The College Festival falls over Easter and runs on Wednesday 27, Thursday 28, Saturday 30 March and Monday 01 April. The campus will be overflowing with 99 teams and 1286 participants from 60 schools. There will be a full programme of football, hockey, netball, rugby, squash, and tennis. Our Thandulwazi Maths and Science Academy will be fielding boys' and girls' football teams, and we are delighted that this year a Thandulwazi netball team will be on the courts.

Our hospitality areas are always a buzz of activity. This year, the OSA (Old Stithians Association) Zone has moved to Henning Field to overlook the football. There will be a satellite OSA GoSolr Zone on Jamieson Field overlooking the rugby being played on Baytopp. In addition, there will be plenty of vendors and activations in the hospitality area and on the Dlamini Oval.

A full list of events is included in this programme but I would like to draw your attention to the events that are open to all. We look forward to seeing you at either the Fun Run or Staff Walk on Monday, 01 April. The run will start from the Chapel at 08h00 and there is the choice of either a 2,5km or 5km course. If you would prefer a more leisurely pace, we have introduced a Staff Walk this year. This starts at the Chapel, beginning at 09h30 and also follows the 2,5km or 5km course.

As a Methodist school, we are mindful that the Sports Festival takes place over the Holy Easter weekend. As Christians, we mark the crucifixion of Christ and his resurrection; we welcome members of any denomination to worship with us. Services will be held on Good Friday in the Chapel (07h45 – 08h45) and on Easter Sunday in the Chapel (09h00 to 10h00). We look forward to spending a time of worship with you.

As I look at the number of schools, teams and participants involved in the 2024 SportsFest, I am in awe of the planning and work that goes into bringing an event of this magnitude to life and making sure that it runs like clockwork. It takes months of preparation, and I am aware of the time and sacrifice made by all involved in the planning and execution of this gala event. I thank the SportsFest team and the many staff from each campus and the different school departments for their contribution to the success of the Festival. It is not only staff who are part of the team but also many of our parents, volunteers and friends of the school who tirelessly give their time and expertise. I am most grateful for your contributions.

An event such as this would not be possible without the support of generous sponsors. We are grateful for the continued and generous support from our main sponsor, Standard Bank. All of our sponsors are listed in the programme and we acknowledge each one for the part that they have played in making SportsFest 2024 possible.






