



Saints Sports Festival Entrance Gate Times and Important Information

NB: FOR YOUR SAFETY AND CONVENIENCE, THE FESTIVAL IS A CASHLESS ENVIRONMENT. WE WILL BE MAKING USE OF SNAPSCAN AND ALL MAJOR DEBIT AND CREDIT CARDS FOR ALL TICKET SALES AND VENDORS.

COLLEGE FESTIVAL 13, 14, 16 and 18 April

Wednesday 13 April 2022

- All St Stithians gates will be open as per normal gate times.
- Gates will close at 22h00.
- There will be no charge for entry to the Saints Sports Festival on Wednesday.

Thursday 14 April 2022

- Tickets will be sold or can be collected from 07h00 until 19h00. (No cash payments).
- Gates will close at 22h00.
- Vehicles with a valid St Stithians 2022 windscreen sticker will not be charged entry until 13h30. A ticket will be required thereafter. (No cash payments).
- All visitors entering the property will be required to pay at the gates (no cash payments) or present a ticket unless accreditation can be provided.

Saturday 16 April 2022

- Tickets will be sold or can be collected from 07h00 until 19h00.
- Bishop Malinga (Peter Place) and Corlett (Bram Fischer) gates will be open for both exit and entry until 16:00.
- From 16:00, Corlett Gate will become an Exit Only gate (to assist with traffic flow).
- From 16:00 Bishop Malinga Gate will have three lanes open for exit and only one for entry.
- All visitors entering the property will be required to pay at the gates (no cash payments) or present a ticket unless accreditation can be provided.
- The One & All (Medfem) Gate will remain open for Higher Ground guests, for staff with 2022 windscreen stickers or staff access cards and for Uber/e-hailing drop-offs and collections.
- Scholars in school uniform attending for compulsory matches will not be charged entrance fee.
- Gates will close at 22h00.

Monday 18 April 2022

- Tickets will be sold or can be collected from 07h00 until 15h00.
- Gates will close at 22h00.
- All visitors entering the property will be required to pay at the gates (no cash payments) or present a ticket for entry until 15h00 unless accreditation can be provided.

Saints Sports Festival Uber Drop Off/Collection

- Please note that from Thursday 13 April, 12h00, all Uber drop-offs and collections will be directed to the One and All (Higher Ground/Medfem Gate) or to the Uber/Parent Drop Off area (opposite Coachman's Inn Restaurant, 36 Peter Place Drive. Tickets will be sold at the pedestrian gate).
- Visitors to the Festival who are attending football and hockey are recommended to make use of the uber drop off area at 36 Peter Place Drive and visitors coming for the netball, tennis and rugby are recommended to make use of the One and All (Higher Ground/Med Fem gate)
- Entrance for those being dropped off will be via a gate at the drop off area.
- A ticket will need to be shown or purchased for entry or accreditation provided (unless it is a Saturday and students are in uniform).

Parent/Uber Drop Off Area (Opposite Coachman's Inn Restaurant, 36 Peter Place Drive)

- Parents and guests who wish to drop off their children will be directed to an allocated area adjacent to the Peter Place gate, opposite the Coachman's Inn Restaurant.
- This drop off area will also be utilised as an Uber/e-hailing drop off area.
- A ticket will need to be shown or purchased for entry or accreditation provided (unless it is a Saturday and students are in uniform).

Covid Checks

- Participants/coaches and managers will be directed to the Covid Marquee set up on the Dlamini Oval and at the Hockey Astros.

Morolo (Hurlingham Manor) Gate

- The Morolo (Hurlingham Manor) gate will only be open for use as a pedestrian gate for the Hurlingham Manor residents for 14, 16 and 18 April.
- A festival ticket or accreditation will need to be presented.
- **No tickets may be purchased at this gate.**

Higher Ground Access

- Higher Ground access via the One & All Gate will be restricted to Higher Ground guests.
- Pedestrian entrance from Higher Ground to the Festival will be via the Staff Entrance gate on Epworth Drive and guests will be required to present or purchase a ticket or provide accreditation.

St Stithians Staff Access

- Thursday 14, Saturday 16 and Monday 18 April: All Staff to enter via the One and All/Medfem gate at the top of Epworth Drive.
- Access will be granted to staff members with a 2022 staff windscreen sticker and/or staff access card.

General Exercising on Campus

- Please note that during the Festival dates (Thursday 13 April, Saturday 16 and Monday 18 April), there will be no free access granted at the gates for exercising on Campus. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Selling of tickets

- No selling of tickets by students will be permitted at any of the gates.
