

A PROUD HISTORY OF ST STITHIANS SQUASH

Squash was introduced as an official sport at St Stithians in 1974 and the College immediately embarked on a course which was to make it one of the top South African schools in squash within the next decade and beyond. In its relatively short history, St Stithians Squash has enjoyed much success, from winning their school leagues all the way through to many players being selected to represent various provincial sides, South African Schools Teams and their country. In the early years, St Stithians Squash was run by Ken and Myrna Hovelmeier who brought their passion and expertise to the discipline, with unprecedented success.

I was delighted to learn that Saints is planning a major development of the squash facilities at the College. My wife, Myrna, and I were privileged to be able to play a meaningful role in the growth and development of squash in the Boys' College from 1978 to 1997, and to share in the achievements of our players both locally and overseas. BENEFITS OF THE SQUASH COMPLEX

Aside from meeting the growing needs of the sport at St Stithians, the new Squash Complex will generate revenue through both national and international tournaments.

St Stithians is committed to broadening the reach of squash to include Egoli squash programmes and students attending the Thandulwazi Academy Saturday School.

Multi-functional use - it is also possible to play other ball games such as indoor basketball, soccer and volleyball.

The expansion of the Squash Complex will ensure that this much-loved sport can be enjoyed by our ever-growing community.

THE FUTURE

At St Stithians we provide a holistic educational experience for all our students, developing not only their minds through our dedication to the provision of the highest level of teaching, but also allowing them to cultivate their sporting skills through the provision of superior facilities.

Squash continues to grow at St Stithians College and the demand for court time has increased. The courts are currently being used by more than 200 students from Boys' College, Boys' Preparatory, Girls' College and the Girls' Preparatory, as well as by the broader St Stithians Community of Belonging. One and All are encouraged to make use of the facilities that we have on offer on our campus and membership and use of the squash facilities is, and always has been, available to our community by the purchase of the squash membership card for a nominal fee. In the interest of growing the sport, there is the planned inclusion of players from the Junior Preparatory and the Thandulwazi Academy. Development of the squash facilities has therefore become a priority for this sports code, particularly as St Stithians intends to host national and international tournaments.

At present there are six courts. The new Squash Complex will add six further courts which will be able to be reconfigured as four double courts through the innovative use of movable sidewalls. An office, gymnasium and a shop are planned.

This Squash Complex will be a Discovery Vitality approved centre.

ADVANTAGES

Doubles Squash - every modern centre will and has to be able to offer doubles squash. More and more major doubles events and championships are being staged all over the world.

Extended training surface - not only for squash, but also for other sports and for different events. It makes sense to have this flexibility in a facility.

TECHNOLOGY

The ASB Movable Wall is a 100mm thick wall that can be moved either mechanically or electrically. The movable wall stops at the programmed places and locks automatically. All electronic cables and mechanics are concealed and pre-installed. Source: ASB
