

Teacher Development Programme



It is a truism that an education system is only as good as its Teachers. The Thandulwazi Teacher Development Programme offers a professional development programme to assist current Teachers and practitioners in improving their teaching skills. This programme focusses on the development and up-skilling of Teachers and School Leaders currently working in ECD Centres and Schools located in previously disadvantaged areas within Gauteng Province and in the town of Modimolle in Limpopo Province (donor project basis); and providing professional growth to these educators. Sessions concentrate mainly on numeracy and literacy in the Foundation Phase; Mathematics, Physical Science, Life Science and Technology at the Intermediate and Senior Phases; and upgrading the leadership skills for School Leaders. Workshops are facilitated by highly experienced Teachers and facilitators, who are all experts in their field.

There is no charge to Teachers attending the workshops – the programme is 100% donor funded to cover the costs of running the workshops.
