Students who are <b>shortlisted</b> from the applications for the Cultural Scholarship will be contacted and will be given further information about the requirements and preparation for their audition. Students who are <b>shortlisted</b> from the applications for the Sports Scholarship can expect their coaches to be contacted for a reference. Please make your coaches aware before listing them as a reference on the application form.
